What are some practical ways to motivate our children to work? (Listen for ideas in class.)

Most of all, we must be women of prayer, and a godly example of working cheerfully for our families.

- 1. Set a timer for 10 minutes. See how much they can get done!
- 2. Compliment a job well done. Show others what they did well.
- 3. Use punch cards for keeping their bedroom clean. Punch every Saturday if the room passes inspection. Prepare a reward when the card is full.
- 4. Give them a power snack just before cleaning!
- 5. Pray for your children's attitudes & character.
- 6. Use a chart to encourage them to succeed. (Stickers in large quantity at Learning Center or Michaels.)

Be patient. Work alongside your children until you are sure they understand what is required.
